

**ORDINANCE NO. 13-16**

**AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE VILLAGE  
SEWER SYSTEM ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village has been working with the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") on the improvement of the roadway for Illinois Route 91 through the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has reviewed its sewer system ordinances in relation to the proposed improvement of Illinois Route 91 through the Village, as the IDOT improvement project will include improvements to the Village's sewer systems located within the right-of-way for the Illinois Route 91 roadway; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village finds that it is in the best interests of the Village to eliminate that provision of the Village's sewer system ordinance allowing the discharge of industrial waste water into the Village's storm water sewer system, and that eliminating this provision will further assist the Village with the IDOT roadway improvements to Illinois Route 91;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUNLAP, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:**

**Section 1.** Title 10, Chapter 1, Section 25 of the Dunlap Village Code is hereby amended as follows (additions are indicated by underline; deletions by ~~strikeout~~)

**§10.01.25 Discharge to Combine Sewers, Storm Sewers, or Natural Outlets.** Stormwater and all other unpolluted drainage shall be discharged to such sewers as are specifically designated as combined sewers or storm sewers, or to a natural outlet approved by the Superintendent of Sewers. ~~Industrial cooling water or unpolluted process waters may be discharged on approval of the Superintendent of Sewers, to a storm sewer, combined sewer, or natural outlet.~~


**Section 2.** This Ordinance is hereby ordered to be published in pamphlet form by the Dunlap Village Clerk and said Clerk is ordered to keep at least three (3) copies hereof available for public inspection in the future and in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code.

**Section 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby superseded and repealed by this ordinance, and any conflicts shall be governed by the ordinance.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and ten (10) day period of publication in the manner provided by law.
