Chapter 14.01

Parks

§14.01.01 Application. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to all property owned by the Village of Dunlap whose use is dedicated to the general public for recreational and general park purposes. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.02 Hours. All parks shall be open from 6:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M. on Sunday to Thursday inclusive and from 6:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. on Friday and Saturday. No person shall be present at or upon any park property at any other time without a written permit from the Village. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.03 Alcoholic Beverages. No person shall drink or possess any alcoholic beverages on any park property without a written permit from the Village. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.04 Motor Vehicles. No person shall operate or park a motor vehicle of any kind on any portion of park property other than those areas specifically designated as roadways or parking lots. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.05 Groups. No group of twenty (20) or more persons shall use any park for organized activity unless they have obtained a permit therefor from the Village Board. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.06 Litter. No person shall deposit refuse or litter of any kind on park property other than in proper containers. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.07 Fires. No person shall light or tend a fire on park property other than in areas specifically designated for that purpose. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.08 Vandalism. No person shall willfully damage or destroy any Village property, either real or personal, that is used for park purposes. (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86)

§14.01.09 Penalties. The violation of any provision contained herein shall be punished by a fine not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not exceeding Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00). (Ord. No. 86-5, 11-12-86; Ord. No. 09-3, 6-10-09 §32)

Chapter 14.02

Use of Village Facilities

§14.02.01 Use of Village Facilities. The use of Village buildings and Village facilities shall be available only to community-based, non-profit organizations or groups on a limited basis as approved by the Village Board or the Village's Building Committee.

§14.02.02 Use of Village Hall. Use of Village Hall will be permitted under the same guidelines as set forth in Section 4.02.01, except that such use shall not be permitted at times when Village Hall is being used for Village business. Further, the use of Village Hall shall only be permitted by outside groups on a non-recurring, occasional basis.

§14.02.03 Certificate of Insurance. Any outside group granted use of Village buildings and Village facilities under this Chapter 14 of the Village Code shall, prior to such use, provide the Village Clerk with a certificate of insurance evidencing general liability coverage in an amount not less than \$500,000 per occurrence with an aggregate limit not less than \$1,000,000.

Prospect Municipal Cemetery

§14.03.01 Application. The provisions of this Chapter of the Village Code shall apply to the Prospect Municipal Cemetery, which is owned by the Village of Dunlap and dedicated for use as a municipal cemetery under the laws of the State of Illinois.

§14.03.02 Hours. Prospect Municipal Cemetery shall be open only during daylight hours during each day of the year. No person shall be present at or upon any Cemetery property at any other time of the day.

§14.03.03 Loitering / Gathering on Cemetery Property. No person shall engage in loitering or lewd conduct upon Cemetery property, and no gathering shall be permitted on Cemetery property, except for Cemetery business, visitation of a burial site, and burial or funeral services.

§14.03.04 Motor Vehicles. No person shall operate or park a motor vehicle of any kind on any portion of Cemetery property other than those areas specifically designated as roadways or parking lots, except as permitted as part of an authorized burial of human remains or related burial service.

§14.03.05 Vandalism. No person shall willfully damage, disturb, or destroy any Cemetery property, either real or personal, or any burial grounds, burial vaults, burials urns, grave site markers or plaques, headstones, or headstone adornments in the Cemetery, except as permitted as part of an authorized burial of human remains or related burial service.

§14.03.06 Alcoholic Beverages. No person shall drink or possess any alcoholic beverages on Cemetery property.

§14.03.07 Litter. No person shall deposit refuse or litter of any kind on Cemetery property other than in proper containers.

§14.03.08 Fires. No person shall light or tend a fire on Cemetery property.

§14.03.09 Penalties. The violation of any provision contained herein shall be punished by a fine not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not exceeding Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00).
